He has an honorary LL.D., Southern New Hampshire University, and an honorary LL.D., St. Anselm's College. He was named as one of the *Best Lawyers in America* by Woodward White for trusts and estates and was also named a *New England Super Lawyer*. In 2010 Heritage United Way honored Kimon with the William S. Green Lifetime Achievement Award and in 2011 the New England Board of Higher Education honored him with the New England Higher Education Excellence Award.
